

Intervention Samdech Techo *Hun Sen* Prime Minister of The Kingdom of Cambodia At the ASEAN Leaders' Interface with Representatives of ASEAN Inter-Parliament Assembly (AIPA)

Finally, ASEAN will continue to adhere to "**unity in diversity**" as our strength, along with **"consensus-based dialogue"** as a fundamental principle in our work. ASEAN will expand its engagement with external partners based on this strength and principle, and we are looking forward for the support from the legislatures of ASEAN member countries.
